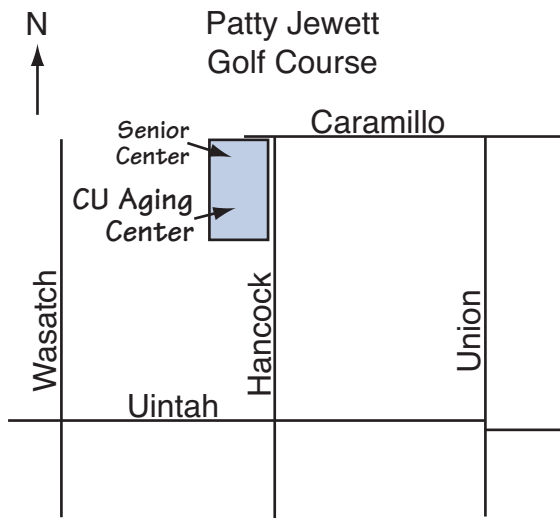
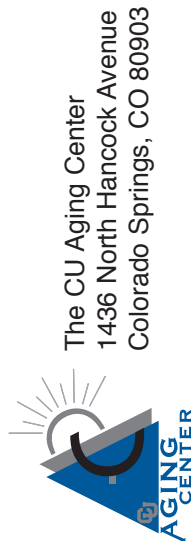

PURPOSE

The CU Aging Center, a community clinic, specializes in addressing daily living challenges, social problems and mental health needs which are unique to individuals in the second half of life. Assessment, treatment and consultation services are provided.

The non-profit clinic operates as an auxiliary of the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs. It serves as a training facility for UCCS graduate students. The students are closely supervised by faculty who are licensed psychologists and experts in geropsychology. Research on aging issues is also conducted at the Center.
