I. POLICY:

- A. In order to allow certainty and consistency in academic operations, it is crucial to have common starting and ending dates for all faculty.

III. PURPOSE:

- A. The normal academic year start date will be one week before the starting date for classes. Faculty appointments will begin on this date or when other funded appointments (e.g. grants or contracts) end and in no case later than the starting day of classes. Exceptions for grant or contract purposes must be explicitly approved by the appropriate chair and dean. The end date will be the date of commencement for that year.
