

WHAT IS WUE?



WUE is the Western Undergraduate Exchange, a program where students in western states may enroll in participating two or four-year college programs at a reduced tuition level equal to 150% of the institution's regular resident tuition.

Participating states are: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming

Approximate Annual Tuition at UCCS for the 2007-2008 year:

Colorado Resident w/COF stipend:	\$6,525
Non-Resident:	\$15,300
WUE:	\$12,510

The University of Colorado at Colorado Springs accepts academically qualified students majoring in Business, Letters, Arts, and Sciences, Engineering and Applied Sciences, and Health Sciences.

Nursing is not offered under WUE. The program is only open to **new**, undergraduate, degree applicants to the University. International students are not eligible for the WUE program.

Assured Freshman Admissions Requirements (see pages 5 & 6 of our Bulletin):

Letters, Arts, & Sciences

- Rank in upper 40% of high school graduating class at the end of the 6th, 7th, or final semester
- 24 Composite ACT or 1080 Verbal + Math SAT
- 2.8 GPA or above
- No MAPS deficiencies

Business & Administration

- Rank in upper 30% of high school graduating class at the end of the 6th, 7th, or final semester
- 24 Composite ACT or 1080 Verbal + Math SAT
- 2.8 GPA or above
- No MAPS deficiencies

Engineering & Applied Science

- Rank in upper 30% of high school graduating class at the end of the 6th, 7th or final semester
- 25 Composite ACT or 1120 Verbal + Math SAT
- 2.8 GPA or above
- No MAPS deficiencies

Health Care Sciences

- Rank in upper 30% of high school graduating class at the end of the 6th, 7th or final semester
- 24 Composite ACT or 1080 Verbal + Math SAT
- 2.8 GPA or above
- No MAPS deficiencies

If selected for the special WUE tuition classification, students acknowledge their intent to maintain their legal residence in the state which is their home state at the time of application to the University. If students desire to change their legal domicile to any other state, including Colorado, they must notify the WUE contact on campus and may lose their WUE eligibility.

Applicants selected for WUE participation must meet the University's criteria for assured admission. After admission, changes to the student's academic major are not permitted without the prior approval of the campus WUE contact. Failure to comply with the above may result in the loss of WUE classification. **For more information, contact the Office of Admissions at 800-990-8227 ext. 3383 or e-mail: admrec@uccs.edu**

Important: To be considered for WUE, mark "WUE" prominently at the top of your application, or state consideration in the essay section of your web application that you are seeking admissions as a WUE student. You are not allowed to apply and enroll and then decide to apply for WUE status at a later date.
