Exam dates: Exam must be scheduled during the week of March 9

Location: You must locate an **acceptable proctor** who is available to proctor you during the exam. Once you have located an acceptable proctor and have scheduled a time to take the exam, contact **Trellis Moore** via email (tgmoore@uccs.edu) to inform her of who the proctor is, the location, the phone number of the proctor and the date and time the exam is scheduled. She needs to contact the proctor to verify the information and give the access code for the exam.

Requirements: A **money order** in the amount of **\$25** made out to Elsevier Science must be mailed to Trellis Moore 24 hours prior to the date of the exam or the access code will not be given to the proctor.
