This (LDE) Program is designed especially for monolingual English speaking teachers, who have English Language Learners (ELLs) in their classrooms, and want to know how to better serve those students. Educators working with individual, small groups or whole classes of English Language Learners will benefit from this Program.

TESL/TEFL Certificate (12 Credits)

There are a series of four (4) courses that will lead to a certificate in Teaching English as a Second/Foreign Language from the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs, College of Education.

Endorsement (24 Credits)

There are a series of eight (8) courses that will lead to an Endorsement in Linguistically Diverse Education from the Colorado Department of Education (CDE). Teachers who have a teaching license will receive an Endorsement to attach to their licenses.

Master's Degree (30 Credits)

Teachers who have a teaching license may use this opportunity to seek a Master of Arts in Curriculum & Instruction (MA in C & I) with an emphasis in LDE. The MA degree is 30 semester hours or 10 courses. The first eight courses are the LDE Endorsement and the last two courses are the research classes that complete the MA in Curriculum and Instruction.
