Special Education Generalist Initial Licensure Undergraduate Program

Undergraduate students wishing to earn an initial educator's license in the field of special or general education need to complete a bachelor's degree in the College of Letters, Arts, and Sciences in addition to a sequence of courses in the Special Education Licensure Program.

To be eligible for licensure, candidates must

- pass the PLACE or PRAXIS Elementary Content test
- successfully complete all courses with a B- or higher
- pass the PLACE Generalist licensure exam prior to student teaching
- complete student teaching experiences
