

CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

Note: The buildings on the UCCS campus are divided into two categories: General Fund and Auxiliaries. General Fund Buildings include academic and administrative functions. Auxiliary buildings include dormitories, athletic, and dining facilities. In some cases, construction standards differ depending on the building category. Confirm building category with Facilities Services Project Manager.

Telecommunications Requirements

1. The UCCS Information Technology Department (IT) should be consulted at each stage of the design process. IT will review all specs produced for the project. Development of a published Telecommunications Standard is projected for the coming years. It is the responsibility of the Consultant to ensure that the IT is consulted and all guidelines put forth by are followed throughout the project.
2. Questions concerning the Telecommunications Standards should be referred to the Information Technology Department.
3. The following Standards are being used:
 - EIA/TIA 569 Commercial Building Standard for Telecommunications Pathways and Spaces
 - EIA/TIA 568A Commercial Building Telecommunications Cabling Standard
