

# UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO AT COLORADO SPRINGS

## Students

- 13,093 unduplicated headcount for AY 2008
- 69% of applicants were admitted compared to 65% at peers
- UCCS full time retention is comparable to and part-time retention is 9 points better than our peers
- UCCS graduation rate for each minority ethnic group exceeds that of our peers

## Core Expenses

- UCCS spends 21% fewer dollars than peers but allocates a larger share to instruction (44%) than our peers (40%)
- Instruction, academic support, institutional support, and student services account for 72% of expenses

## Core Revenues

- UCCS generates 93% as much revenue per FTE enrollment as our peers despite \$6,171 average lower state appropriations
- 51% of UCCS core revenue is from tuition and fees versus 32% among peers

## Employees

- The student-to-faculty ratio is 17 students per faculty
- UCCS has a larger proportion of employees who are faculty (49%) compared to our peers (41%)

## Tuition & Aid

- UCCS tuition and fees were \$644 less than our peers
- 33% of full time new degree-seeking undergraduates received grant aid compared to 68% among our peers
- UCCS students were less likely to receive a loan and when they did, the loan amount was \$538 less than the peer average

## Comparison Group

- UCCS has 31 peer institutions from 18 states including 7 high research and 5 doctoral/research universities
- UCCS is classified as a master's large institution by the Carnegie Foundation
