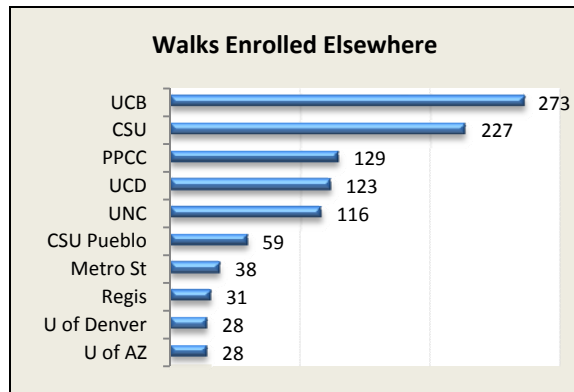


## Students Who Go Elsewhere

We submitted two files to the National Student Clearinghouse to identify subsequent enrollment at other institutions among (a) “walks” or students admitted to UCCS who did not enroll at UCCS and (b) non-retained UCCS undergrads—students who did not return in Fall 2009 after being enrolled in Fall 2008.

**Fall 2009 Walks.** The Clearinghouse provided information on 74% of the 2,712 students identified as walks. The bar chart illustrates the top 10 institutions at which potential UCCS students enrolled in Fall 2009. All but the University of Arizona are institutions in Colorado.



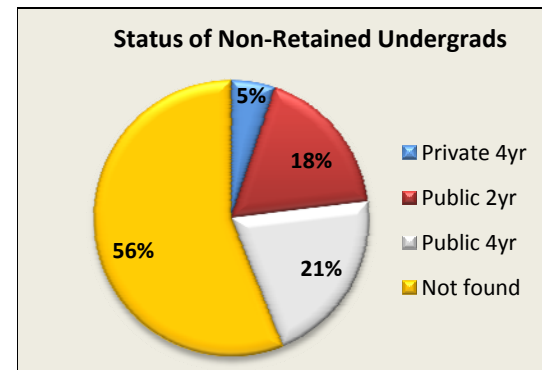
Most of the walks (73%) enrolled at public 4-year institutions as opposed to public 2-year (13%) or private 4-year (14%) institutions.

Overall, walks enrolled at 455 different institutions in 49 states. Approximately 59% were in Colorado; other states are illustrated in the table along with the number of non-retained students going to each state.

\*Five walks and 5 non-retained students were enrolled at the University of Phoenix, an online institution that is not necessarily in Arizona.

**Fall 2009 Non-Retained Undergrads.** We submitted a list of 1,309 non-retained undergrads including students from every class level but excluding students who graduated. Approximately 44% enrolled at another institution and 56% were not found at another institution.



The majority of the enrolled students are at Colorado institutions (73%). The remaining 27% enrolled at one of 127 different institutions in 43 states. The top 10 institutions are illustrated in the bar chart below.
