## 2011 Kraemer Family Library Live Intergeneration Storytelling Contest Guidelines

### **When:**

Tuesday, February 15<sup>th</sup> from 6pm to 8pm in Clyde's (University Center lower level).

### **What:**

The goal of this contest is to recognize storytelling as a way to understand different generations. Storytelling informs, educates and entertains. Tell a story – fiction, non-fiction, or a combination. Include characters from at least two different generations.

Storytelling ideas may include, but are not limited to:

- Stories from an older person, like a grandparent, you have heard
- Stories you think you might tell your children or grandchildren
- Stories from history (with a personal note)
- Stories from different cultures (with a personal note)

### **Guidelines:**

- Story not to exceed 5 minutes.
- Story must be original, unpublished, and not prepared by a second party
- Please do not reveal information that could in any way either violate the privacy of others or reflect on them in a negative way
- Do not use any language that would be considered profane
- Use only first names, nicknames or relationships to identify characters
- Storyteller grants non-exclusive right to Sponsors to record and replay stories
- Judges reserve the right to stop any story that violates any of these rules

### **Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> Prize - \$250; 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize - \$150; 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize - \$100**

Winners will receive cash prizes immediately after announcement of winners. Winners must be present and personally accept prize.

### **Eligibility:**

Must be a UCCS part-time or full-time student. Entry form can be obtained online at <http://www.uccs.edu/~library/spotlight.html>. Up to 12 storytellers will be selected. Entry forms will be accepted at the library circulation desk January 24 through Feb 8.

### **Jury:**

Three judges from the UCCS campus will listen to the stories and rate each performance based on content and delivery. Judges will announce 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners within 15 minutes after the last storyteller finishes. All judges' decisions are final.

### **Audience:**

Students, faculty, staff and the general public are encouraged to listen. Reserve any applause until after completion of each story. The event will also be videotaped and made available online.
