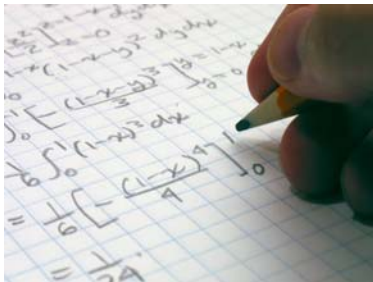

The CU Succeed Program

Since 2001, UCCS has partnered with local area schools to deliver University credit for approved high school math courses.

The Department of Mathematics identifies University-qualified high school

teachers who have agreed to teach their courses in accordance with the



University's standards. The content of the high school course is essentially identical to the content of an on-campus undergraduate mathematics course.

Student Eligibility

The CU Succeed courses are open to any student who is regularly enrolled in an approved high school course.

Students who successfully complete a CU Succeed course earn university credit.



CU Succeed Courses

Pre-Calculus — Math 105 (4 credit hours)

AB Calculus — Math 135 (4 credit hours)

BC Calculus—Math 135 & 136 (4 credit hours each)

Statistics—Math 281 (3 credit hours)

To Register

Obtain the CU Succeed online registration instructions from your high school math instructor. In addition to your online registration, you must also complete the CCHE Statewide Agreement form, also available from your teacher or counselor. **Registration for all 2008-2009 sections will take place November 10-December 5, 2008.**

Tuition cost

CU Succeed tuition is only \$40 per credit hour. In some circumstances, students may be required to pay for textbooks or other course materials.

Program Benefits

- ◆ 75% savings in tuition cost compared to on-campus instruction
- ◆ Convenient courses offered at your high school during regular school hours
- ◆ A chance to earn college credit while meeting high school graduation requirements
- ◆ Credit is issued based on a student's performance throughout the year, not solely on one test result
- ◆ Participating schools receive a portion of the tuition to support high school programs
- ◆ Students receive credit on an official UCCS transcript
