The amounts above are projections of the average cost for Lower Division students (60 credits & below) living on campus per academic year. The tuition & fees amount are based on enrollment in 12 credit hours per semester. SEOG, Pell Grants, Student Loans, Academic Scholarships (Colorado Centennial Scholars), and On-Campus Employment (including work-study), do not count as resources toward these budgets. The College Opportunity Fund is estimated at \$86 per credit hour, and may vary each year. Many Colorado residents will be eligible for this stipend, but students must apply for and authorize this source of funding. The above amounts are estimates and are subject to change.

This is only an offer sheet for your information. The final scholarship agreement will be attached to the National Letter of Intent should you agree to attend the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs. Transfer and walk-on student athletes will receive an official financial aid agreement.
