### Objectives:

- ◆ Students are encouraged to enroll in an internship through the Community Service and Learning course or the Smart-Girl program.
- ◆ Courses in this program are concerned with the new scholarship on women and gender which reflects the growing influence of women in all aspects of our society and examines issues such as:
  - ◇ the state of women's public and private lives
  - ◇ women and the law
  - ◇ women's ethnic and cultural diversity
  - ◇ women's historical contributions
  - ◇ women's scholarship in the humanities and the natural and social sciences
  - ◇ masculinity and men's lives
  - ◇ gender issues
