**Transfer Worksheet for ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE–BUSINESS OPTION
2009-2010**

This worksheet is intended for students attending Colorado Community Colleges (CCC) with plans to complete the Associate of Arts degree (Business Option) and transfer to the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs (UCCS). The worksheet will outline the degree program at Colorado Community Colleges and indicate how the courses will fit with the Bachelor of Science (Business) at UCCS. Students who complete the Associate of Arts (Business Option), as outlined in the Statewide Articulation Agreement found at <http://highered.colorado.gov/Academics/Transfers/Agreements/business.pdf> shall be fully considered for admission into the business programs offered by the participating four-year public colleges. Students must maintain a 2.7 GPA and earn 60 credit hours in order to be admitted to the College of Business with junior class standing.

Students are encouraged to apply to the University Connection Program. Those in the program who earn the Associate of Arts degree prior to transfer may be eligible for a first-semester scholarship and other benefits.

NOTES

1. All College of Business students must complete the University Composition Competency requirement. After completing both CCC ENG 121 (UCCS ENGL 131) and a Non-Freshman Communication Elective course, students must either submit a Writing Portfolio or enroll in an additional writing course. Please consult a business advisor in the Student Success Center for complete details.
2. Two required Math courses; MAT 121 College Algebra **or** MAT 123 Finite Mathematics, **and** MAT 125 Survey of Calculus, by the College of Business at UCCS.

Check with your community college course bulletin to verify if certain courses are required for your AA Business Option in the areas of Science, Social and Behavioral Sciences, and Humanities.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The following information applies only if the student completes the AA degree prior to transfer. It is understood that after a student has been admitted to the College of Business, all courses will be taken in residence at University of Colorado at Colorado Springs.

1. Transfer students with a minimum 2.0 GPA will be considered for admission. However, in order to be accepted to the College of Business, students need a 2.7 GPA.
2. Courses accepted in transfer to the College of Business at UCCS are not necessarily accepted for transfer to any other school or college in the University of Colorado System. Interested students should consult the transfer guide of the school/college on the University of Colorado campus to which they wish to transfer.
3. The University of Colorado at Colorado Springs College of Business will accept 60 semester hours in transfer from Colorado Community Colleges.
4. A minimum of 45 semester hours of upper-level (300/400) course work in residence is required for the Bachelor of Science in Business degree at UCCS.
5. Only courses with a grade of “C-” or better will be accepted in transfer.
6. Students transferring into a baccalaureate business program with the AA degree may follow the graduation requirements specified in the catalog during the academic year the student began their study at the community college, provided that the student: 1. Maintains continuous registration at the community college, 2. Enrolls at the four-year college within one year from the last registration date at a community college, and 3. Does not interrupt continuous registration at UCCS for a period no longer than three consecutive semesters.
7. Students accepted to the College of Business degree program will receive notification from the UCCS Admissions Office. An academic advisor will complete an evaluation of transfer work. Transfer students will receive a copy of their evaluation when they attend the required Transfer Orientation session.
