Who intend to transfer to the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs (UCCS)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Beth-El College of Nursing & Health Sciences at UCSS generally grants admission to the nursing program to transfer students who have 30 credit hours of transferable college level work and who have achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.3 or better. While transferability of credits is determined by the Office of Admissions, final application to the degree program is determined by the College of Nursing and Health Sciences. Students who meet admission criteria are admitted into the Nursing program under Nursing Prep. Nursing Prep students complete general education requirements while awaiting an invitation into the clinical portion of the program. GENERAL INFORMATION

Advanced Placement for LPNs

Beth-El offers a Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree (BSN), which prepares the graduate for professional practice and leadership roles. The graduate provides care for individuals, families, groups and communities. Students who are not RNs will follow the four-year curriculum plan. Students with bachelor or associate degrees in fields other than nursing will also follow this plan but may have advanced placement due to completion of some (or all) of the general education requirements.

All students seeking advanced standing will be required to meet the same prerequisites and terminal objectives of the college as traditional students. Advanced placement credit may be obtained by transfer or credit examination. Advanced placement student must have an active unrestricted LPN license in Colorado and have completed at least 30 credit hours of transferable college level work with a cumulative GPA of 3.3 or better prior to application.
