


UCCS Faculty Representative Assembly

- Depending on the results of motions on the agenda for this meeting there are potentially 2 issues that will be presented to the faculty before the end of the semester. Please encourage all eligible faculty in your respective colleges to participate by completing the ballots that will be sent out via email. It is important that we know the desires of the faculty for both topics in order to move forward with planning and recommendations.
- There are 141 students scheduled to graduate this semester who have a Friday/Saturday/Sunday course final that will conflict with Commencement on December 14. Emails have been sent to the faculty teaching those courses asking that they accommodate the students who are scheduled to graduate so that the students may attend their commencement ceremony.
