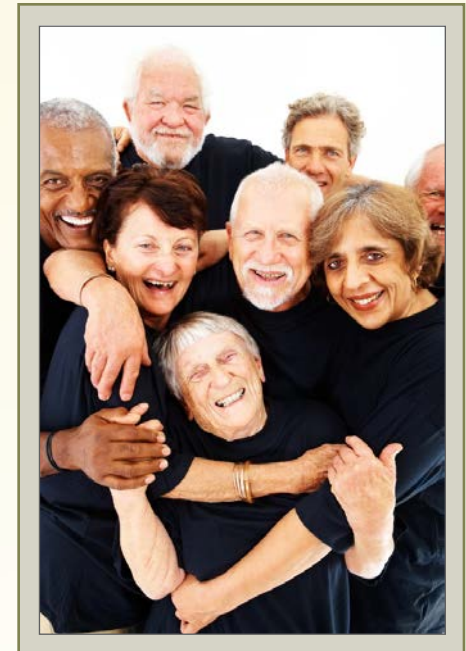

## Professional Advancement Certificate in Gerontology

The program enhances understanding of aging-related issues by providing the most up-to-date information and research findings in the field of gerontology. The course features a faculty of academic researchers, experienced practitioners, and professionals involved in fields related to aging. The presenters include members of the University of Colorado faculty, professionals and experts from areas of health, law and government; representing the public, nonprofit and private sectors.

The certificate course consists of two semesters taken in sequence. New enrollees are accepted each semester. Successful completion of the program requires class attendance and participation, and a few site visits. A total of six class absences are allowed during the two semesters.

ONLINE ACCESS. The PACG course can be accessed live or in recorded form in addition to the in-classroom option at the same cost. Instructions for accessing through Webex, an internet-based platform for both PC's and Mac's, will be provided after enrollment. You can watch and participate as if you were in the room. Or if you cannot attend on Tuesday evenings, you can access the recorded version of the class at a later date/time.

Tuition is \$495 per semester and requires a \$250 deposit at the time of registration with the remaining balance due by October 31st (fall) or March 15th (spring). Please note that if paying by credit card, full tuition is due at the time of registration. You may drop the course (written notice required) any time before it begins without penalty. A full refund will be provided if the course is canceled.

No refunds will be granted once the second class has occurred.

- **Aging in the 21st century**
- **Physiological, biological, sociological & psychological aspects of aging**
- **Medicare & Medicaid**
- **Cross-cultural look at aging**

- **Government's role & policy issues**
