OLD BUSINESS

1. IT lab refresh

- a. Jerry reported that the refresh was coming along; that the deal had been made for a site license for Vista and Office 2007, but that he may have to charge a small fee to departments to help defray its cost; that there should be a sufficient number of “old” machines to bring the rest of the campus up to the necessary system requirements; but that he as yet had no timetable for replacing faculty and staff computers and upgrading faculty and staff software.

2. Wireless campus

- a. Jerry also reported that the plan for making the campus wireless has gone through all the approval processes; that it should be implemented by summer.

3. SIS

- a. Jan reported that a vendor had been chosen for the SIS system; that it would be announced next Wednesday.

4. Clickers

- a. David informed the committee that we’ll be going to a new clicker system—i>clicker; that a handful of instructors will be using it this semester; and that it will be implemented fully in the fall.

5. IT lab image software

- a. David also commented that responses to the image software survey had been taken into account in the new image; that some concerns about SPSS had been addressed and sorted out.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Course Management System selection

- a. Several members provided lists of features they felt were critical in a CMS, and after discussion of some of them, David offered to compile the list, pass it back to the committee for review, and give it to Sue Byerley to forward it to the Faculty Assembly Committee for their comment.
