1. Summary of Onecard Conference – Chattanooga, TN October 18-22
 - a. Onecard Terminal to be offered as a web based application
 - i. Interface much more intuitive and easier to use.
 - ii. Mounting of G drive not necessary
 - iii. Modern day Windows 8-like dashboard with “Favorite” tiles
 - b. Custom Reporting
 - i. Brand new third party reporting tool to be integrated into Onecard
 - ii. Will allow fully customizable reporting.
 - iii. Programming knowledge will be required.
 - iv. Output formats PDF, Excel, Word, Text file
 - c. Local DB door controllers
 - i. Door controllers will run embedded windows!
 - ii. Controllers will have locally updated copy of access DB, thus allowing near instant access verification and door operation.
 - d. Smartphone door access via Bluetooth (plus additional hardware)
2. VAV
 - a. Onecard terminal access for Rebecca, Missy and Yonas
 - i. Working with Rob Garvie; planning on this week.
 - ii. Steve would like a card reader at his desk.
 - b. Door Access Issues?
 - i. Custodians given 24/7 access to RF (already have VAV access)
 - ii. Anyone else?
3. DFS
 - a. Is system reporting in a satisfactory state?
 - b. Gift Card loading possible at POS
 - i. Yes, this is possible. Tungsten will discuss details with Nick.
 - ii. Concerns of Munch Money fraud was brought forward.
 - Solutions discussed
 - a. Manager swiping in to load Munch Money
 - b. Employees have to swipe in for accountability purposes
 - c. Roaring Fork
 - i. Still working with Network admins on a DCT3 solution so that POS may return to convenience store.
 - ii. Alpine Express (convenience store) will be opening Spring 2016
