Attendance:

1. Conference Summary from Tungsten and Paul
 - a. Interesting Information- Heartland was stating the whole OneCard system is going Mobile with everything.
 - i. Mobile apps can be used with paying for meals and accessing doors such as housing and faculty areas
 - ii. Problems may arise with security issues such as if the phone is accessed doors can be opened easily
 - iii. There is a chance we could utilize pins and fingerprints access for the app
 - b. Road maps-The systems are currently ready to go if we pay for the modules. Bluetooth beacons can be setup at doors with battery power that will last for two years.
 - i. If your phone with the app is near the door you will be able to access the door. The range of access can be set up on Bluetooth device
 - ii. For Cashiering there will be a system similar to Apple pay allowing user to access munch money.
 1. Bookstore could be integrated into the Lion One Card system
2. Updates on the Mobile App
 - a. Door/ Event Access
 - i. Would require a Bluetooth beacon to be installed in the doors. The new hardware system for housing would be easy to install and maintain and could be tied into the windows systems.
 - b. View Account Info
3. OneWeb Implementation
 - a. One account
 - i. Faculty/staff accounts are the priority
 1. Will need to re-card some individuals
 2. There will be one card and one ID number
 3. Need to drop role based pictures on card
 4. Problems may arise from staff members who are students from charges on the number based accounts and students who become staff members may have problems
 - ii. Timeframe
 1. No set time frame however plan will be worked on during the spring and will hopefully be implemented during the summer
4. Advanced Reporting Tools
 - a. Want to upgrade for Advanced Reporting Tools
5. PAX Terminals

- a. There was an Issue with Wells Fargo and the contract but the devices should be here now. Working with the Mailroom.
- 6. Surface Pro installation
 - a. We are testing one.
- 7. One Card Office
 - a. Met last week to look at funding models.
 - b. Possible looking at elevated privilege for UC to deal with one card where students can deal with the system however students would need FERPA training.
- 8. Area Updates
 - a. University Center/Photo ID
 - i. Printers for maintenance
 - 1. Fargo no longer has support for the system
 - ii. We want to print less and less ID's while moving more towards mobile however there may need to be a purchase for another printer in two to three years
 - b. Housing
 - i. General fund- Flex accounts- going over into the negative
 - 1. Finding ways to deal with the situation
 - c. Dining Services
 - i. Looking to expiring gift cards after five years
 - 1. Extending beyond one year would help to maintain business and after five years these funds would be reclaimed
 - 2. Disclaimers and graphics on the gift cards would need to be changed.
 - d. Rec Center
 - i. Nothing of note
 - e. Library
 - i. No real issues
 - f. Ent
 - i. Harmony left downstairs and Alvin is taking her place
 - g. Door Access
 - i. Needing more spare readers
