2. Munch Money

- Kirk – changing to Clyde’s cash starting Fall 2017
- Pauline- Changing because we want the book store to be able to use Clyde’s Cash
- Kirk – needing to update website form Munch Money to Clyde’s Cash
- Kirk- once someone has left the university, they forfeit their munch money/clyde’s cash

- Paul- each place that accepts munch money/clyde's cash will get a percentage of the forfeited munch money/clyde's cash
 - Kirk- waiting until spring to integrate the Bookstore. Starting integration in the Fall

 - Kirk- System is set up exactly the same as munch money until the bookstore is added on

 - Joel- in the process to changing to a system without barcodes for checking out books
 13. Ent
 - Tim- what else uses the barcode on the back of the card?
 - Kirk- just the library
 - Joel- we are keeping the barcodes for now
 - Kirk-trying to get the rec center to start scanning the barcode as well as excel centers, magnetic swipe causes issues with the ent card

- Kirk- about 30% are Ent lion one cards

15. One account for one card system

- Kirk- reprogrammed for lion card, testing to make sure it is working properly, also need to link accounts for existing students/employees
- Kirk- ACTSTU group is for active students who are not enrolled yet, Student group is for enrolled students
- Joel- will people with 2 IDs still be able to use both?
- Kirk- For faculty/staff who were previously students all IDs will continue to be functional but from this point forward new faculty/staff will have one ID.
- Kirk- override group means I don't do anything with the groups at all
- Tungsten- someone is removed from a group but they are still a student, what happens then?
- Kirk- whoever puts the student in override group has control
- Kirk- plan is to turn this live on Friday
- Kirk- makes sense for the long run, two accounts are hard to manage
- Stacey- should I just ask for names instead of ID numbers
- Kirk- for now yes

- Tungsten- working on being able to put them where we want/need them, can start testing them
- Stacey- columbine and UC Coffee shops want them
- Tungsten-register each one online and then can be installed
- Kirk- they show up this week, can you get them registered and installed before the fall semester starts?
