

Alpine Village Apartments Opening Procedures for: *Antero, Crestone, Shavano*

Opening Day: Friday, August 23rd, Check In Hours 9:00 am to 10:00pm

When you arrive to campus...

Alpine Village is located at 4645 Stanton Road on the northwest side of campus. Check in will begin at 9am in the LaPlata Lobby (LaPlata is the second building on your left as you walk into the Village off Stanton Road). We encourage that only the student stand in line for their housing check-in in order to help the process go faster and to keep the length of the lines down. When you arrive to campus, please park in the Alpine parking garage located on Stanton Road. **Access in and out of this garage will be limited to ONLY the North entrance, on Stanton Road; the east entrance will be blocked off.** A campus map can be found by clicking here: <http://www.uccs.edu/Documents/facsrvs/CampusMap.pdf>.

If you are checking in on Saturday or Sunday, the LaPlata Office will be open from 8am to 10pm.

If you plan on arriving to check in after Sunday, August 25th, you must notify the office via email at housing@uccs.edu.

Student rooms will be held until 8:00am of the first day of classes. If the student has not checked in by this time, the room will be released and made available to students on the waitlist, unless the student has notified the Residence Life Office that they will be checking in at a later date. In no cases will student rooms be held for more than one week from the first day of classes.

Don't forget your student ID card!

- ✓ You will need to bring your UCCS student ID to be checked in. If you do not have your student ID, you can bring a valid government-issued ID instead.

Parking for Move-In

Once you have checked in, you will be able to begin unloading your vehicle. All unloading will need to be completed in the Alpine Parking Garage. There will be a limited number of moving bins available for checkout; however, if you have a cart or dolly you can bring from home, it will speed up your move in process.

- Handicapped unloading access will be located along Alpine Village Way, which is adjacent to Cucharas and LaPlata. **Please note that a handicapped placard will be required in order to park in this area, and no other unloading will be permitted.** Parking in this area is limited and there will be a queue. Our parking enforcement officers will be there to assist and direct you.

To live on campus, you will need to meet immunizations requirements. For more information on meningitis, visit: <http://www.uccs.edu/recwellness/health-services/immunizations/meningitis.html>. Staff from the UCCS Wellness Center will be available to answer any questions and collect immunization records on move-in day.

Resident Parking Permit Registration

Vehicle registration for parking will be required as of 8:00am on Monday, August 26th. If you have not registered your vehicle or have parked in a lot other than the residential areas in the Alpine Parking Garage located off of Stanton Road by this time, you will be ticketed.

A parking permit is included in your housing fees, so there is no need to pay an additional fee! No physical parking permit is required, but you will need to make sure to register your vehicle online through this website beginning August 6th: <https://www.uccs.edu/pts/parking/students/student-permit-registration>; make sure you know your license plate number to save time when registering! Parking will be stationed with other campus resources throughout the day if you have additional parking questions.

Housing Orientation

All apartment resident students are asked to check-in by noon on Sunday, August 25th. Beginning at 4:30 pm on Sunday, Housing orientation will begin; check with your Resident Assistant (RA) for your meeting location. After orientation, there will be an Alpine Village BBQ in the Crestone Lounge at 5:30pm. Check with your RA for more information.

One last thing...security and safety

Fall opening day is the only day we unlock our building doors. The buildings will be open when you arrive and will lock at 5:00pm.
