

Village at Alpine Valley Residence Halls Opening Procedures for: *Cucharas, LaPlata, SanJuan*

Opening Day: Tuesday, August 20th
Check-In Time: Beginning at 1:00pm

When you arrive to campus...

The Village at Alpine Valley is located at 4645 Stanton Road. When you arrive to campus, please park in the Alpine parking garage located on Stanton Road. **Access in and out of this garage will be limited to ONLY the North entrance, on Stanton Road; the east entrance will be blocked off.** If you plan on bringing a trailer or U-Haul, please contact Erik Newhouse at enewhous@uccs.edu or [719-255-3578](tel:719-255-3578) for further information. We encourage that only the student stand in line for their housing check-in in order to help the check-in process go faster and to keep the length of the lines down. Once you have parked please proceed to the following check in area:

- If you live in San Juan House, please come to San Juan House 1st floor lobby.
- If you live in Cucharas House, please come to Cucharas House room 105.
- If you live in LaPlata House, please come to Kettle Creek on the East side of the Roaring Fork Dining Hall.

There will be signs to direct to you to the appropriate location from the Alpine parking garage.

Beginning at 3:00 pm Tuesday, check-ins for all buildings will be relocated to LaPlata House Lobby; the lobby will remain open until 10pm.

We ask that all students be checked in no later than 12pm on Wednesday. However, if you need to check in Wednesday or later, please come to LaPlata House Lobby when you arrive. Check-in hours are 8am to 10pm Wednesday to Sunday.

If you plan on arriving to check in after Sunday, August 25th, you must notify the office via email at housing@uccs.edu.

Student rooms will be held until 8:00am of the first day of classes. If the student has not checked in by this time, the room will be released and made available to students on the wait-list, unless the student has notified the Residence Life Office that they will be checking in at a later date. In no cases will student rooms be held for more than one week from the first day of classes.

Don't forget your student ID card!

- ✓ You will need to bring your UCCS student ID to be checked in. If you do not have your student ID, you can bring a valid government-issued ID instead, but having your student ID will expedite check in. You will also need your student ID to access the buildings.

To live on campus, you will need to meet immunizations requirements. For more information on meningitis, visit: <http://www.uccs.edu/recwellness/health-services/immunizations/meningitis.html>. Staff from the UCCS Wellness Center will be available to answer any questions and collect immunization records on move-in day.

After you have received your keys...

Once you have checked in, you will be able to begin unloading your vehicle. All unloading will need to be completed in the Alpine Parking Garage. There will be a limited number of moving bins available for checkout; however, if you have a cart or dolly you can bring from home, it will speed up your move in process.

- Handicapped unloading access will be located along Alpine Village Way, which is adjacent to Cucharas and SanJuan. **Please note that a handicapped placard will be required in order to park in this area, and no other unloading will be permitted.** Parking in this area is limited and there will be a queue. Our parking enforcement officers will be there to assist and direct you.

Campus Resources

After you have checked in, please stop by the 1st floor Cucharas classroom (Tuesday, August 20th 1pm to 4pm) to check in with the Student Health Center, and visit with other on-campus resources.

Resident Parking Permit Registration

Vehicle registration for parking will be required as of 8:00am on Monday, August 26th. If you have not registered your vehicle or have parked in a lot other than the residential areas in the Alpine Parking Garage located off of Stanton Road by this time, you will be ticketed.

A parking permit is included in your housing fees, so there is no need to pay an additional fee! No physical parking permit is required, but you will need to make sure to register your vehicle online through this website beginning August 6th:

<https://www.uccs.edu/pts/parking/students/resident-parking> make sure you know your license plate number to save time when registering! Parking will be stationed with other campus resources throughout the day if you have additional parking questions.

Loft Kits

Lofting kits are offered on a first come, first served basis, and are available to all residents. If we run out of stock, we will place you on a waiting list. We always have loft kits returned to us throughout the fall term. We have a limited supply of lofting tools available for check-out during the move-in process. We ask that you loft your bed as quickly as possible and return the tools to the lofting check out station. **If you have a 3/16 inch allen wrench (hex key) and a 1/2 inch socket wrench, please bring them along and it will speed up your lofting.**

- If you wish to loft your bed, you will need to bring your room keys to the LaPlata office to receive a loft kit. You will need to complete a loft waiver and you will be instructed how to loft your bed.

Refreshments and Lunch

On Tuesday, August 20th there will be several water stations set up in the Village for you to enjoy. Lunch will be served from 12:30pm to 3:00pm in the Roaring Fork Dining Hall.

Regular board dinner will begin at 5pm Tuesday in the lower Lodge and Roaring Fork dining hall; you will need to bring your Student ID card in order to access the dining halls beginning Tuesday evening. Please check the informational boards for dining hours prior to the start of classes.

Dining hours will be posted on each of the floors in housing. Check out the online menu!

Housing Orientation and Clyde's Kick Off

Tuesday, August 20th: At 7:00pm, there will be an ice cream social in Summit Village for all residents; consult your RA for more details.

All resident students are asked to check-in by noon on Wednesday, August 21st. Beginning at 1pm on Wednesday, Housing orientation will begin; check with your Resident Assistant (RA) for your meeting location. After orientation, your Resident Assistant will escort you to the Playfair, dinner and RecFest.
